ISCA A&TSIP Scholarship

At ISCA there is an integrated college community of International and Australian students, which embraces all cultures and benefits from breadth and diversity. It is a key value of ISCA to enable students from all backgrounds to have an opportunity to study at tertiary level. ISCA provides scholarships for both tuition and accommodation, to help Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples.

These scholarships are of varying values and to a maximum of \$20,000. These Scholarships provide tuition fee waivers to a level decided by the ICMS Scholarship Board in each case.

This is also able to consider Accommodation/Living Costs scholarships for the eligible applicants of various values and duration. Tuition and/or accommodation/living cost funds are disbursed directly to ISCA on behalf of the recipient of the ISCA A&TSIP Scholarship.

Value: UP TO \$20,000*

Applications Due: 5pm Friday 19 April 2024 (for the May 2024 study period)

How to Apply:

- 1. Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria found below
- Complete your application and prepare your report supporting your application and other documentation if required

Eligibility:

The eligibility requirements for the ISCA Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarships are as follows:

- 1. Can demonstrate being an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person
- 2. Must have successfully completed Year 12 (HSC Record of Achievement or equivalent***).
- **3.** Applicants under any of the above categories must prepare a one-page report in support of their application (refer to Report for details).

Meeting the scholarship eligibility criteria doesn't guarantee that you'll be awarded a scholarship. The ICMS Scholarship Board will reserve the right to decide to award these Scholarships.

- * Value of Scholarships varies according to the course undertaken and may vary from the estimated value printed here, and from year to year.

Report:

Please submit a one page report addressing the following points:

- Why do you believe you should be awarded this scholarship?
- Why ISCA?
- Why is your chosen course the best choice for you?
- Any other information you wish to include to support your application

Selection Process:

- The application form (and any supplementary information) is designed to gather sufficient information from applicants to determine which applicants best meet the eligibility criteria and can progress to the panel interview.
- Students who meet the eligibility criteria will progress to the interview stage. The interview is conducted by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- ICMS Scholarship Board will award the ISCA A&TSIP Scholarships after considering the information contained in the applications submitted and the completed panel interview.
- The decision of the ICMS Scholarship Board is final.

Offer Material:

If your application and interview for this Scholarship is successful, you'll receive a scholarship offer with your letter of offer for a place in your course.

Your offer material will include details about the scholarship you've been awarded and the terms and conditions for accepting the offer.

When you accept a Scholarship offer, you must agree to provide any personal information requested by ICMS Scholarship Board to assess your ongoing eligibility for the Scholarship.

Your Scholarship offer is made on the condition that you remain eligible to receive the Scholarship on each census dateduring the currency of your Scholarship.

Deferment:

Deferment of this Scholarship is not permitted prior to your course or during.

Students awarded this Scholarship who defer the start of their studies or who withdraw from their course, will forfeitheir Scholarship. Students may re-apply for a scholarship if they start studies at ISCA at a later date.

Termination of this Scholarship:

If the Scholarship you've been awarded is for longer than one year, it will be terminated if:

- The maximum duration of the Scholarship has been reached (if applicable)
- You've failed to make satisfactory academic progress as defined by ISCA

NOTE: Scholarship submissions will not be returned. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Terms & Conditions

- 1. The Scholarship recipient is required to sign this acceptance form and return to the ICMS Scholarship Board on or before enrolment.
- 2. International Sport College Australia (ISCA) Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship are non-transferrable, meaning the scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
- 3. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
- 4. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high. Subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- 5. With respect to the sometimes sensitive nature of the ISCA A&TSIP Scholarship, this scholarship will not be announced at any event or ceremony.
- 6. The Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ISCA.
- 7. The recipient of ISCA Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and rules and regulations prescribed by the ISCA whilst enrolled.
- 8. The recipient acknowledges and upholds the confidentiality of receiving the Scholarship.
- 9. The recipient must commence the program in the term commencing May 2024.
- 10. The Scholarship offers a tuition wavier and/or accommodation/living costs credit. Any additional tuition payment may be covered by Fee-Help*

Accommodation/Living Costs Credit description:

Rooms are equipped with a desk, wardrobe, heating and wireless internet. All linen is provided and rooms are dusted and vacuumed once a week. Each floor is equipped with a kitchenette, common showers, toilets and ironing facilities. You will also receive residential support from the residential assistants.

Your accommodation/Living Costs credit includes the following for the duration of the scholarship credit and eligibility:

- Rent
- 3 x Meals per day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) Monday to Friday
- 2 x Meals per day (Brunch and Dinner) Weekends
- Electricity, Gas & Water
- On site parking
- Campus wide Wi-Fi
- 11. If the recipient of the Scholarship fails a subject, he / she may be obliged to retake the subject at their cost; this decision will be at the discretion of the Chair of the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- 12. ISCA provides support and assistance, through the Academic Learning Department and Wellness Department here at the college. It is expected that the student where required or needed will be proactive in seeking these services as required in order to complete their studies to the best of their ability.
- 13. The Scholarship offers a tuition waiver and/or accommodation that can only be used for the purpose and duration of attending ISCA for the program as specified. The balance of additional fees, including any uniforms, books and other program related costs for each enrolling Term must be paid in full prior to Term commencement.
- 14. The Scholarship is not able to be deferred.
- 15. The Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ISCA Degree.
- 16. The Scholarships may be discontinued by the College, dependent upon termly review of academic standing, professional conduct, appropriate conduct and College and Community Contribution hours (if applicable).
