

ISCA A&TSIP Scholarship

At ISCA there is an integrated college community of International and Australian students, embracing all cultures and the benefits of such diversity. It is a key value of ISCA to enable students from all backgrounds to have an opportunity to study at tertiary level. ISCA can provide scholarships for both tuition and/or accommodation, to help Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples.

These Scholarships provide tuition fee waivers to a level decided by the ICMS Scholarship Board.

The ICMS Scholarship Board is also able to consider Accommodation/Living Costs scholarships for the eligible applicants. Tuition and/or accommodation/living cost funds are disbursed directly to ISCA on behalf of the recipient of the ISCA A&TSIP Scholarship.

Value: UP TO \$20,000*

Applications Due: 5pm Friday 21 November 2025 (for the February 2026 study period)

How to Apply:

- 1. Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria found below
- Complete your application and prepare your report supporting your application and other documentation if required

Eligibility:

The eligibility requirements for the ISCA Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarships are as follows:

- 1. Can demonstrate being an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person
- 2. Must have successfully completed Year 12 (HSC Record of Achievement or equivalent***).
- **3.** Applicants under any of the above categories must prepare a one-page report in support of their application (refer to Report for details).

Meeting the scholarship eligibility criteria doesn't guarantee that you'll be awarded a scholarship. The ICMS Scholarship Board will reserve the right to decide to award these Scholarships.

- * Value of the Scholarship is indicative only and varies according to the course undertaken and may vary from the estimated UP TO value printed here, and from year to year.

Report:

Please submit a one page report addressing the following points:

- Why do you believe you should be awarded this scholarship?
- Why ISCA?
- Why is your chosen course the best choice for you?
- Any other information you wish to include to support your application

Selection Process:

- The application form (and any supplementary information) is designed to gather sufficient information from applicants to determine which applicants best meet the eligibility criteria and can progress to the panel interview.
- Students who meet the eligibility criteria will progress to the interview stage. The interview is conducted by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- ICMS Scholarship Board will award the ISCA A&TSIP Scholarships after considering the information contained in the applications submitted and the completed panel interview.
- The decision of the ICMS Scholarship Board is final.

Offer Material:

If your application and interview for this Scholarship is successful, you'll receive a scholarship offer with your letter ofoffer for a place in your course.

Your offer material will include details about the scholarship you've been awarded and the terms and conditions for accepting the offer.

When you accept a Scholarship offer, you must agree to provide any personal information requested by ICMS Scholarship Board to assess your ongoing eligibility for the Scholarship.

Your Scholarship offer is made on the condition that you remain eligible to receive the Scholarship on each census dateduring the currency of your Scholarship.

Deferment:

Deferment of this Scholarship is not permitted prior to your course or during.

Students awarded this Scholarship who defer the start of their studies or who withdraw from their course, will forfeitheir Scholarship. Students may re-apply for a scholarship if they start studies at ISCA at a later date.

Termination of this Scholarship:

If the Scholarship you've been awarded is for longer than one year, it will be terminated if:

- The maximum duration of the Scholarship has been reached (if applicable)
- You've failed to make satisfactory academic progress as defined by ISCA

NOTE: Scholarship submissions will not be returned. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Terms & Conditions

- 1. The Scholarship recipient is required to sign this acceptance form and return to the ICMS Scholarship Board on or before enrolment.
- 2. International Sport College Australia (ISCA) Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship are not refundable and non-transferrable. The scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
- 3. The Scholarship Recipient agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and all requirements in the student handbook whilst enrolled. (https://handbook.icms.edu.au/)
- 4. The recipient must commence the program in the term commencing February 2026.
- 5. If the Scholarship Recipient fails a subject, he/she is obliged to retake the subject at their cost at the full subject price.
- 6. The Scholarship is a tuition waiver (and/or accommodation) waiver that can only be used for the purpose of attending ISCA for the program as specified. The balance of remaining fees, including tuition, accommodation, uniforms, text books and any other program related costs for each enrolling study period must be paid in full prior to study period commencement.
- 7. In certain cases, the scholarship amount awarded will be credited to tuition as a portion of the fees in each study period for the duration of the course of their study or until the scholarship credit is exhausted. In some cases, scholarship credit can and may be applied to a later study period than the commencement study period.
- 8. In the case of the scholarship recipient discontinuing studies any and all remaining credit will be forfeited.
- 9. The value of the scholarship and the timing of the credit apportionment are not negotiable and not changeable.
- 10. At no time will any scholarship credit apply to fees already paid.
- 11. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high. Subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- 12. With respect to the sometimes sensitive nature of the ISCA A&TSIP Scholarship, this scholarship will not be announced any event or ceremony.
- 13. The Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ISCA*.
- 14. The recipient acknowledges and upholds the confidentiality of receiving the Scholarship.
- 15. The Scholarship offers a tuition wavier and/or accommodation/living costs credit. Any additional tuition payment may be covered by Fee-Help**

Accommodation/Living Costs Credit description:

Rooms are equipped with a desk, wardrobe, heating and wireless internet. All linen is provided and rooms are dusted and vacuumed once a week. Each floor is equipped with a kitchenette, common showers, toilets and ironing facilities. You will also receive residential support from the residential assistants.

Your accommodation/Living Costs credit includes the following for the duration of the scholarship credit and eligibility:

- Rent
- 3 x Meals per day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) Monday to Friday
- 2 x Meals per day (Brunch and Dinner) Weekends

- On site parking

- 16. ISCA provides support and assistance, through the Academic Learning Department and Wellness Department here at the college. It is expected that the student where required or needed will be proactive in seeking these services as required in order to complete their studies to the best of their ability.
- 17. The Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ISCA Degree.
- 18. The Scholarships may be discontinued by the College, dependent upon termly review of academic integrity, standing and student conduct.
- 19. Academic Integrity will be reviewed from time to time. Any academic misconduct can inhibit your scholarship. Academic misconduct registered as level 2 or 3 during the applicable scholarship, will result in immediate discontinuation of the scholarship.
- 20. The Scholarship is not able to be deferred.
- 21. College fees are subject to change.
