The ISCA Manly Rugby Scholarship rewards performance, dedication, passion, community contribution and academia. The ISCA Manly Rugby Scholarship represents a professional advantage to your CV and a very valuable endorsement of you as an individual.

If you are a player members of Manly Rugby Mermaids or Manly Rugby 1sts Colts, a passionate person with lots of energy and interest in the Sports Management world, we believe that you should apply.

Value: UP TO \$10,000 tuition waiver* (Accommodation and Living Cost Credit may be

awarded at the discretion of the Scholarship Board)

Applications Due: 5PM on Wednesday 14 January for the February 2026 study period.

*Please note: Partial Scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high.

All scholarships awarded are subject to approval by the Scholarship Board. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.

Applying for a Scholarship with ISCA

- The scholarships listed above are open to Australian and New Zealand citizens/permanent residents completing either year 12 (NZ: year 13) studies or who took a gap year in 2025
- Applicants must ensure they have submitted a Direct Application and returned their signed Acceptance Declaration to college admissions prior to being considered for an ISCA Manly Rugby Scholarship
- Applicants must be a player members of Manly Rugby Mermaids or Manly Rugby 1sts Colts
- The presentation, content, relevance and creativity of the application and the academic merit of applicants will be considered
- Applications close 5PM Wednesday 14 January 2026.
- Late applications will not be accepted
- Applications must be submitted in hard copy or via email
- Applications will not be returned to the applicant, please do not include any original documentation and make copies of all references
- Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Board led by the Chairperson of the Professional Scholarships Program
- Finalists will be chosen based on stages one and two of this application
- Finalists will be required to sit a Panel Interviews and must be available in person. (Refer Stage 3 information on the following page)
- Scholarship winners will be chosen from the group of finalists
- It is preferable for students that have registered with UAC to place ISCA as their highest possible preference

NOTE: Scholarship submissions **will not be returned**. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Application Process

STAGE 1 - REFERRAL

As an applicant, you must include a referral from a school principal, career advisor, sport club manager or dean of studies (or similar). The referee must complete the attached form including a written reference with information about your personal qualities, academic ability, achievements in the school community and any other relevant information. You may include more than one referral in your application, provided one of the above listed referees is one of those.

Please ensure the attached Referral Form is complete and signed by your referee.

STAGE 2: REPORT

Please submit a detailed report addressing the following points. (Minimum 500 words)

- 1. How will you personally benefit from an education at ISCA?
- 2. Outline your experience in working in teams and how you intend to apply that experience during your time at ISCA.
- 3. Consider your career goal for the future. You have graduated from ISCA. Describe your position and explain how your experiences at ISCA have helped you reach this level.
- 4. How do you describe balancing sport and study? What are they key lessons you can share?

The following documents must also be submitted with the report.

- Last set of high school transcripts and/or trial results
- School, community or sporting awards and/or leadership roles
- References (personal and/or work)
- ISCA Application form (if submitted online, please print a copy of the submission OR your Letter of Offer received by the Admissions department)

STAGE 3: INTERVIEW

Based on the results of Stages 1 & 2, a short list of finalists will be selected for a Panel Interview by the Scholarship Board. The Interview will be conducted at the ICMS campus in Manly, NSW, will be used to further ascertain the candidates'.

STAGE 4: ACADEMIC

The final scholarship recipients will be selected based on the results of Stages 1 through 3, and final Year 12 (NZ: Year 13) results. All interviews will be held on campus at ICMS, 151 Darley Road, Manly, NSW.

Terms & Conditions (please read carefully before signing the declaration)

- The Scholarship Board's decision is final.
- ISCA and/or Manly Rugby reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship at any time for poor sports or academic performance or inappropriate conduct (see ISCA Student Handbook).
- The ISCA Manly Rugby Scholarship offers a tuition waiver **UP TO the value of \$10,000**. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high. Subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
- In certain cases, the scholarship amount awarded will be credited to tuition as a portion of the fees in each study period for the duration of the course of their study or until the scholarship credit is exhausted. In some cases, scholarship credit can and may be applied to a later study period than the commencement study period.
- The Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ISCA.
- · Recipient must be a player member of Manly Rugby Mermaids or Manly Rugby 1sts Colts.
- · College fees are subject to change.
- ISCA Manly Rugby scholarships are not refundable and non-transferrable, meaning the scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
- The applicant must ensure they have a submitted Direct Application and returned their signed Acceptance Declaration to college admissions prior to being considered for an ISCA Manly Rugby Scholarship.
- The recipient of the scholarship agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and rules and regulations prescribed by ISCA while enrolled.
- The recipient of the ISCA Manly Rugby scholarship must commence the program in the February 2026 study
 period and is not able to defer study at any time during his/her scholarship. It is the responsibility of the recipient
 to contact the Admissions Manager at the ISCA to apply for commencement within the specified period.
- If the recipient of an ISCA Manly Rugby scholarship fails a subject, he/she are obliged to retake the subject at his/her cost.
- The Scholarship is a tuition waiver that can only be used for the purpose of attending ISCA for the Diploma of Sport Management (High Performance). The balance of remaining fees, including accommodation, uniforms, books and any other program related costs for each enrolling study period must be paid in full prior to study period commencement.
- The Scholarship recipient is expected to complete some contribution hours** each study period.
- The Scholarship recipient must actively participate in at least one student committee and be a Student Ambassador each study period while studying on campus (not necessary during industry training).
- The Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ISCA Diploma of Sport Management (High Performance).
- ISCA Manly Rugby scholarships may be discontinued by the College, dependent upon termly review of sporting and/or academic standing, professional conduct and College and Community Contribution.
